Enrolment Fees		
Application Fee	\$250	Payable at the time of completing an enrolment application. This is non-refundable.
Enrolment Confirmation Fee	\$1,250	Payable on acceptance of an Enrolment Offer. This is non-refundable.
Tuition Fee Deposit	\$2,000	Payable by first day of Term 3 the year before commencement and deducted off Term 1 Fees upon commencement.

Tuition fees include the provision of tuition, careers counselling, pastoral care, use of library and sporting equipment/facilities, kitchen, science laboratories/equipment, class sets, photocopied materials, curricular excursions, camps, levies and Athletics software. Additional school requirements such as stationery, textbook hire, replacement identity cards and lost library/textbooks are a parent's responsibility. Tuition fees exclude optional academic courses and optional student activities.

#A sibling discount will be applied in the instance where two or more domestic students P-12 from one family attend St Aidan's at the same time. Fee discounts are reviewed by School Council annually and are subject to change. Fee concession types are mutually exclusive with the higher discount being applied. Other concession types include bursaries and scholarships. Parents are reminded that any fee concessions received are dependent upon the fees being paid by the due date. Concessions (including scholarships, bursaries and sibling discounts) may be withdrawn if this condition is not met.

Payment Methods

St Aidan's issues fee statements each term (Kindy – Year 11) by email. Year 12 students are billed across three terms. Accounts must be paid in full on or before the first day of each term or annually by the first day of Term 1. Payment methods include:

- BPay (preferred payment method - no surcharge applies)
- via Parent Lounge (surcharge applies to credit card payments)
- Mastercard/Visa/AMEX in person or over the phone (surcharge applies to credit card payments)
- Edstart Payment Plan
- Cash payments are no longer accepted, please contact the finance office should you need to discuss other payment options

[^]**AEAS test:** Students applying for entry to St Aidan's in Years 4 to 11 (excluding Year 7 students commencing at the beginning of the school year), are required to sit additional testing prior to commencement. These assessments are held at St Aidan's. The fee listed must be paid for by the parent directly to AEAS.

[†]**EALD Testing:** EALD students are required to sit additional testing prior to commencement. This exam is conducted and supervised by St Aidan's.

VET: VET Sector courses on offer; if required, the fees information will be provided separately at the time of enrolment into the course.

Payment Terms

It is the intention of the School Council to set fees once each year, however, the School Council reserves the right to revise fees and fee policies at any time.

Late Payment Fee

Accounts not paid by the due date, and for which no suitable arrangements have been made, will attract a monthly Late Fee of \$80. St Aidan's cannot provide education to students where fees remain unpaid. It is a policy of St Aidan's that a student may not take their place at the school at the start of a Term where fees for a previous Term remain unpaid.

Optional activities will not be available to students if fee accounts are not paid in full. Monies paid for optional activities will be directed to tuition fee accounts in this situation. This includes exchange programs, overseas tours, co-curricular sporting camps/tours, and private music or speech and drama lessons.

Notice of Withdrawal

The school requires **one full term's written notice** to the Principal to withdraw a student from school, or one term's tuition fees in lieu of notice will be payable. Verbal notification, or notification to staff members other than the Principal, is not considered due notice.

Edstart Payment Plan

Edstart allows you to pay your school fees in weekly, fortnightly, or monthly instalments. You can spread your fees evenly across the school year, as well as reduce your repayment amount by extending the cost over a longer time frame. For more information, visit www.edstart.com.au/staidans.
